### 8.0 COMMUNICATIONS

8.1 Modernization update- Kris Ingrao shared that the front drive is completely finished. Everything was striped during the week. New fencing is going up. The gates are not in, possibly in one week or two. All closed for decorative fencing. The landscaping is two days in. The plants will be in tomorrow. All across the front, there will be several miniature olive trees. We put a planter by the Wellness Center and two large trees near Marquee. We have drought resistant landscaping and some gravel will be included. We have two big parking lot lights that were installed. We have half of the power to the Cafeteria building. The kitchen has 98% of its appliances. The ovens and ice maker are wired; lights are in and working. The deadline for the kitchen will be met by Monday or Tuesday after inspections (fire, health). A/C will be fired up tomorrow. We had a plumbing issue. Once the A/C is running, we can focus on the Cafeteria. When the temperature drops, plastic sheeting will go in for easy to wipe down for the walls. Flooring will be done by Friday. We will be able to get people in by Back to School Night. We still need to get curtains for the stage. The sound system, projector screen and the freezer will be here mid September. We will fire up the walk-in refrigerator on Sunday and can use the walk-in freezer. The ornamental gate is going up and we will have a walkway to preschool. All spots where cement was broken are now re-seeded. We have samples of the OC sign, one has acrylic finish and is raised off of the wall with a border behind the logo. The second option is no background, only logo off the wall without any trim. Mr. Cerrillo suggested a powdered coating finish.

At the Monday meeting, two ladies joined from Las Planchas. He will meet out there at 8:30 am, the vote will take place at 9:20 am. Hopefully, City Council will vote against the annexation.

### 13.0 REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT

- Leadership Council Meeting -Monday, 8/11 the meeting held 30 people in opposition to the project. Questions were asked and we were given seemingly or misleading answers. The company did not know the information to some of the questions and did not provide a map. There was no interpreter, so, I stepped in to interpret. This project is not welcome and there was a full room supporting this. The Superintendent had an impromptu meeting with the mayor over zoom about this project. A statement was provided to CBS47 that we as a district do not support this project. We are waiting on a traffic study and environmental reports. It has been reported by Crowne real estate representatives that the City of Fresno told Central Trucking company that this is a great area for the project. The City of Fresno Council meeting will take place tomorrow, the Superintendent will be in attendance for the vote. I have submitted my letter to City Council.
- ASP 30 students on waitlist, ASP/ELOP grant decreased; site lead
  position is now a 6 hr position. The reduction in staff includes: decrease in
  Site Lead hours, decrease in one tutor and one door monitor position.
- First day of school -went smoothly, kids worked hard and everyone was where they needed to be. Kinder has a 1:10 ratio, we would like to reduce the waitlist. We do not have a VP this year, the work load is disseminated well. Ms. Langley orders curriculum, Mrs. Bloodgood and Miss Cortes are working proactively to decrease attendance concerns. The Superintendent has absorbed class scheduling and all district matters.
